Portfolios

- Each student will build a portfolio to show evidence that they have learned all the criteria on the tracking sheet

What Will They Get From This Program?

- Each unit is listed on the school leaving certificate
- Award / Certificate / Diploma
- Entry 3 / Level 1 / Level 2

Award

- Minimum of 6 credits
- Minimum of 2 units (3 credits each)
- Award will be of the level that 50% of credits are carried out in
- Can be achieved in Year 9

Certificate

- Minimum of 21 credits (maximum of 36)
- Over 50% credits must be at level of overall qualification
- Normally achieved at the end of Year 11

Diploma

- Minimum of 38 credits
- Over 50% of credits must be at the level of the overall qualification
- Level 2 Diploma is the same as an O'Level

THE PROCESS

- Internal Verification three times a year
- Only a selection of students registered will be checked
- Suggestions for improvements

THE PROCESS

- External verification three times a year
- After Internal Verification
- Only selection of students registered will be checked
- Used to be sent to the UK but now are checked in Malta
- If students submitted pass, all students in that group will pass

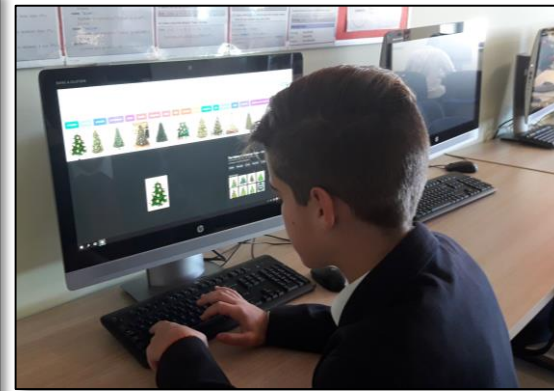
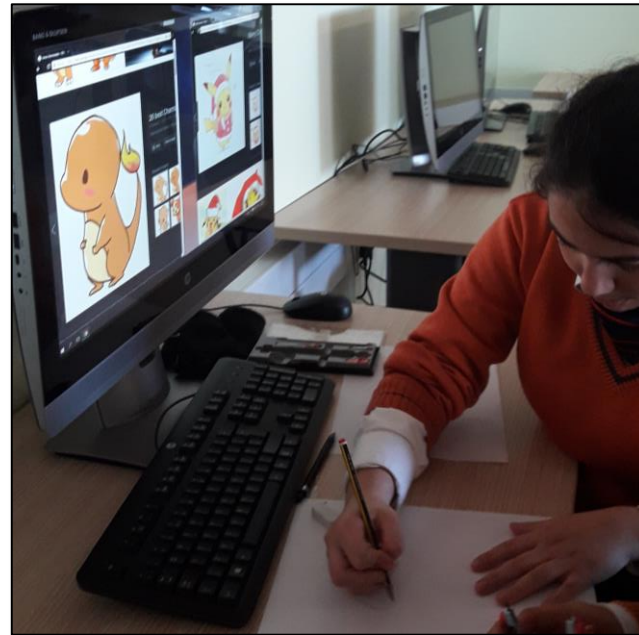
PTI ACHIEVE IN OUR SCHOOL

- Most of last year's group have already obtained a Level 1 Award and are now working towards obtaining a Certificate

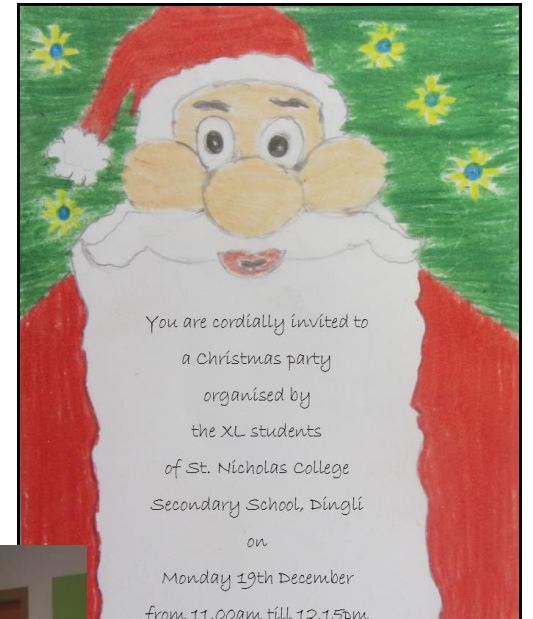
YEAR 9 GROUP WORKING ON THE HEALTHY EATING UNIT
